Relative clauses

Using:

When we want to give more information about **people**, **animals** and **things**, we often use a **relative clause**:

We can use **that** with people, animals and things.

We can use **who** with people.

We can use **which** with animals and things.

Examples:

The people who you live with...

Things that you are afraid of...

Something **which** you have wanted to do...

An animal which you look after...

The film stars **that** you like...

The girl who is talking on a mobile...

The sport which you play...

A pet which you would like to have...
